

Guidelines towards France visa submission

France visa rejections being noticed due to following factors –

- Not giving proper interview at Campus France
- Not giving proper information about the college/course that the student is going to study
- Not giving valid air tickets and accommodation confirmation
- Lack of presentation in SOP/Statement of motivation
- Insufficient funds or documents from sponsors

Hope these points shall be helpful for visa success rate:

1. Previous academic history - A lot of students come with big gaps since the last qualification obtained hence it's important to cover up those gaps with evident documentation which could be verified.
2. English proficiency - It's important to establish on what basis college assessed English proficiency for the candidate and supporting documents should be submitted accordingly.
3. Accommodation – It is recommended to obtain services given by the college or book it via authentic sources or websites.
4. Financials - Considering higher expenses in Paris city, should show additional funds and strong income back up from the acceptable sponsors (Blood relations preferred)
5. CA net worth certificate - Showing strong movable and immovable assets from acceptable sponsors would give a strong impression of financial standing in the home country and this shall be considered a strong incentive for returning home after degree.
6. Statement of motivation or Purpose - This is one of very important documents from the student side which is usually being assessed by the embassy after Campus France interview. The Embassy very occasionally calls students in person hence giving these statements with proper story format is highly recommended.
7. Tips for SOP – Suggest the students to give full family, academics, experiences, gap details with proper reasoning, why this course, college and France, subjects covered in the intended program and their relevance with candidate's background and future goals, future plan of action in home country and overall benefits which may come after this degree.

Campus France interview session –

Kindly ask student to go with smart casual or formals.

The below mentioned questions are noted as per our experience with the Campus France and are **only sample questions and suggestions**, any questions or information related to his academic background can be asked from the student.

1. **Question-** Please explain yourself?
Answer - Mention your academics, your experience if any, which city you're from.
2. **Question-** Please tell all your academic qualifications and which all universities you obtained kindly mention in chronological order?
Answer - Start from class 12th or school and followed by other college degrees.

3. Question- Please tell your program duration and total tuition fee?

Answer – Follow as per offer letter presented to you.

4. Question- Which program and institute you're going to in France and why?

Answer - Mention full name of the college and the program name and the student should say that he is going for international exposure considering its overall quality and delivery of the program.

5. Question- Why did you not consider any other college for this program?

Answer - Make sure your answer should be logical and simple -

Example - I did explore many other colleges in France but interestingly in this college I am getting a unique combination of European and English culture, which means French school offering British degree in association with The university for the creative arts therefore I have decided to finalize this school for my further studies.

6. Question- Do you have any such plans for moving to any other institution or other European country ?

Answer - not really, otherwise i would have directly applied to BSBI Germany campus. I am keen to study in France due to its culture and environment.

7. Question- How do you propose to fund your studies and accommodation?

Answer- Please mention the proper funding shown by you and over all funds and your sponsor's background. Make sure you mention the funds shown by you (like Saving account, FDs, Bank Loan etc) Campus France manager should be see that you are aware about the expenses that you might incur in France.

8. Question- What are your future plans ? What type of employment would you obtain after this program?

Answer - Practical answer about your future goals and which all segments of jobs you would be doing.

9. Question - Do you have any plans for staying back in France ?

Answer - No, I have my plans for coming back to India or my home country. Campus France manager should have a clear impression of your confidence for coming back and you don't even need any such help for part time work because you and your sponsors have adequate funds.

10. Question- How do you see this degree relevant to your previous background?

Answer - Mention the subject and try to connect dots with your future planning etc.
