# Information about Lithuania



**Region:** Located in Northern Europe (Baltic region)

**Bordered By:** Latvia (north), Belarus (east & south), Poland (south), Russia – Kaliningrad (southwest), Baltic Sea (west)

**Capital:** Vilnius

**Population:** ~2.8 million

**Language:** Lithuanian (one of the oldest languages in Europe); English widely spoken among youth and in universities

**Currency:** Euro (EUR)

**Major Cities:** Vilnius (Capital & largest) | Kaunas | Klaipėda | Šiauliai

**Climate:** Lithuania has a temperate climate influenced by the Baltic Sea – Mild to warm summers and cold, snowy winters

# Why to choose The Lithuania?

- ❑ MOI (Medium of Instruction) accepted — IELTS/TOEFL not mandatory (but recommended for visa strength)
- ❑ Affordable tuition fees compared to many European countries
- ❑ Programs fully taught in English, especially at Master's level
- ❑ Students can work up to 20 hours/week
- ❑ Average part-time wages: €5–€7 per hour
- ❑ Part of the Schengen Area — travel across multiple European countries
- ❑ 1-year stay-back option after completion of Bachelor's or Master's degree
