Academic requirements:

Bachelors:

55% and above in grade XII

UG Diploma:

55% and above in grade XII

PG Diploma:

50% and above in tertiary qualification

Masters:

50% and above in tertiary qualification

English proficiency requirements:

IELTS, PTE and TOEFL all the three are accepted, below are the requirements for IELTS, TOEFL and PTE

- ✓ Work Experience Documents
- ✓ University & Course specific Statement of Purpose (Must be unique & non- plagiarized)

Part-time work rights for international students:

- Part-time is allowed in Switzerland.

Post Study Work Visa for international students:

- Post Study Work Visa is for 1 year

Visa Process for international students:

➤ Documents Required

- Valid national passport
- Passport size pictures
- Visa application forms
- Personal covering letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- Acceptance / confirmation / registration letter from the school, university, etc...
- Proof of academic degrees
- Financial Documents

➤ Visa Process

- Students have to personally visit Delhi High Commission for interview & visa file submission with prior appointment only.
- This process takes a minimum of 8 weeks to complete.
- After visa approval, college will send a confirmation letter that student's visa has been

approved and now student will have to transfer the balance fee within the next 2 days

- After receiving the full fee, the institute will send us the Visa Authorization Letter.
- Student need to take the appointment from the nearest VFS Office to submit the passport for visa stamping. This procedure will take a minimum of 3 days to complete after submitting the passport to VFS Office.
- Student then buy his flight tickets and reach Switzerland.

➤ Processing Time

- Visa applications for the purpose of study will be transmitted for decision to the competent Swiss immigration authority where the applicant intends to reside. The Embassy is only allowed to issue an entry visa upon receipt of a positive decision or authorization.
- Please note that the Embassy might be instructed by the School / University / the deciding cantonal authority to ask for additional documents.
- Please do not send documents by fax or by e-mail to the Embassy. All documents have to be submitted with the visa application.
